## GENERAL PRICE LIST

These prices are effective as of July 13, 2021 but are subject to change without notice.

The goods and services shown below are those items we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

**BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF----- \$1,875**

Our services include; conducting the arrangement conference; planning the funeral; consulting with family and clergy; shelter of remains; preparing and filing of necessary notices; obtaining necessary authorizations and permits; coordinating with cemetery, crematory, or other third parties. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements that you select.

**EMBALMING ----- \$825**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. **(Add \$200.00 for autopsy or organ donor case.)**

**OTHER PREPARATION OF THE BODY----- \$295**

Bathing, cosmetizing and dressing of the body. This fee will also be assessed when restoring an unembalmed, autopsied decedent.

**USE OF FACILITIES AND STAFF FOR VISITATION----- \$525**

Up to 4 hours of visitation included: 1 hour of family time with 3 hours for public viewing

**USE OF EQUIPMENT AND STAFF FOR HOME VISITATION----- \$525**

For use with visitation and funeral when cremation will follow services

**OTHER SERVICES****FORWARDING OF REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME----- \$2,935**

Our charge includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; removal of remains and embalming.

(The charge does not include a shipping tray.)

**RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME----- \$2,915**

Our charge includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; proportionate share of overhead costs; care of remains, one night visitation; staff and equipment for graveside service; and transportation to cemetery. (This price does not include cost of an outer burial container. Some cemeteries may require one.)

**IMMEDIATE BURIAL----- \$2,525**

Our charge includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; removal, and hearse. (This service does not include casket, grave opening or vault.)

**IMMEDIATE AQUAMATION (Alkaline Hydrolysis) ----- \$1,795**

Our charge for direct aquamation via alkaline hydrolysis (without ceremony) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; removal of remains within 50 miles; filing of death certificate and cremation permit. We will be happy to mail ashes to you, however, postage is an additional cost. As of January 1, 2021, we can no longer do payment plans for direct aquamations or cremations.

**IMMEDIATE CREMATION----- \$1,995**

Our charge for direct cremation (without ceremony) includes: alternative container; basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; removal of remains within 50 miles; transportation to crematory, filing of death certificate and cremation permit. We will be happy to mail ashes to you, however, postage is an additional cost. As of January 1, 2021, we can no longer do payment plans for aquamations or direct cremations.

**POSTAGE-----\$50 and up**

Postage charges incurred when mailing ashes to family members (\$50 minimum, may increase dependent on weight)

**THIRD PARTY FEES**

**GRAVE OPENING AND CLOSING, and SET UP----- \$700 to \$1200**

This is a cash advance item and may be due at the time arrangements are made. (Cash or check to Hulsey Grave Service.) Additional fees might include \$150 for oversize graves and \$250 per hour for rock break up at gravesites.

**RADIO OBITUARIES----- \$15-\$25**

WBTR-Carrollton (\$15), WGMI-Bremen (\$15), WKNG-Tallapoosa (\$15), WGAA-Cedartown (\$25)

**NEWSPAPER OBITUARIES**

Obituaries in the local papers are placed according to the wishes of each family. There is still a “free” version, but only lists the name and service information. The Gateway Beacon and Times GA range in price from \$40-\$100 each. Pictures can be included for \$35 per paper. The Atlanta Journal-Constitution offers a free listing with the name of the deceased and service information. If a detailed obituary is requested for the AJC or the Anniston Star, there will be a ‘per line charge’ to be preapproved by the family. The Cleburne News charges \$16 for an obituary.

**DEATH CERTIFICATES**

**GEORGIA-----\$25 for the first copy, \$5 for each additional**

**ALABAMA-----\$15 for the first copy, \$6 for each additional**

**FLORIST**

Some families may wish to purchase a floral spread to go on top of the casket. This price will depend on the florist and type of flowers you choose.

**PAYMENT TERMS**

We accept all major credit cards, cash, check, or money orders.

We will also be happy to file your life insurance for you with an assignment to pay for our services.

We do not charge to file your life insurance except for special circumstances.

If we are expecting to experience severe death certificate delays due to an autopsy or if the estate is named as an insurance beneficiary, we pay impose a fee to file your insurance.

**As of January 1, 2021, we can no longer do payment plans for direct Aquamations or cremations.**

**DISCOUNTS**

We offer a 3% discount on contracts paid in full before the funeral with cash or a check.

If paid with a credit card, we offer a 1% discount.
